2017 Kids Fishing Tournaments

LCC will be sponsoring youth fishing tournaments this summer for ages 3-16. The top two from each age group will participate in a finals tournament held in August. Each individual tournament will include a lunch, medals, and big and little fish prizes. There will be a \$2 fee per child to help pay for prizes and lunch. Registration will start at 7:30a and the tournaments will be from 8-11a. Kids do not need to attend all the tournaments to qualify for the finals.

Paddle at Pollmiller - Friday, June 9, 2017 - Pollmiller Park Beach Area - 7-9p

Join the LCC naturalists for a paddle around Pollmiller Park Lake to enjoy the sunset and evening wildlife. Participants can stop by the beach area any time between 7-9p to try out a kayak or canoe. All equipment including lifejackets will be available and staff will be on hand for basic instruction. Equipment and paddling time may be limited based on number of participants. There is no charge for this event.

Skunk'n to the Mississip' Canoe Float - Saturday, June 17, 2017 - 1p

See another, quieter side of Iowa on a canoe float on Iowa's Skunk and Mississippi rivers. The trip will last approximately three hours. Attendees will meet at Green Bay Access take-out point and will be shuttled to the Skunk River Access to begin the float.

Canoe rental is \$15, with a maximum of three persons per canoe. Must be twelve years of age to attend and those under age eighteen must be accompanied by an adult. A canoe handling and safety demonstration will be provided before the float. **Pre-registration is required.** Call (319) 463-7673 to sign up.

Horseback Riding - Saturday, July 22 & October 21, 2017 - Shimek State Forest - 2-5p

Join a naturalist and the Westercamp family on a three hour ride through Shimek State Forest. No experience needed! Horses and snacks are provided. **Pre-registration and pre-payment is required and space is limited to 12 riders.**

The fee is \$35 per rider and all participants are required to sign a waiver form. Must be at least 10 years-old. Under 16 accompanied by an adult. Maximum weight for a rider is 225 pounds. No double riders. Directions will be given upon registration. In the event of rain we will contact each rider. Refunds will only be made if LCC cancels the ride. To register call (319) 463-7673.

Migrating Monarchs - Saturday, September 16, 2017 - Lee County Conservation Center - 1-3p

Learn about monarch butterflies, then go on a monarch hunt. We will have a short presentation about monarch life cycle, what they eat, where they live, and how we tag and track their long migration! We will have live monarch caterpillars on hand, and some adults to tag. Then we will send you on a hunt to see if you can catch and tag your own wild monarchs. Cost is \$2 per participant.
