## KINDERGARTEN

### **Baby Animals**

Students will see “Are you my Mother” puppet show and play a matching game where students match the adult animal with the baby animal.

### **Salamanders**

Students will learn about salamanders through a story, hide n seek game, color sheet and best of all they will get to see a live salamander.

### **Feathers For Lunch**

Students will learn to identify different kinds of birds and hear their calls and listen to *Feathers for Lunch*, by Lois Ehlert. They will also make a mosaic bird craft.

### **Trees**

Students will listen to *The Secret Life of Trees*, take a peek inside a large wooden tree to discover who lives there and learn about trees. They will also make a magnet leaf craft.

### **The Mitten**

Students will listen to the story “The Mitten.” After the story they will make a mitten and decorate them with glitter and animals from the story. Please let us know the number of students in your class when signing up so we can have all the materials.

### **Wild Turkey**

Students will enjoy a turkey story, learn about wild turkeys, hear its call, touch feathers, play turkey hide n seek, and make an edible turkey craft. If you would prefer to not do the edible craft, please let us know when you schedule.
