These programs are offered November 15 through March 15, you may call at any time to schedule, the sooner the better, since calendar fills up fast. Most programs last 30 minutes. All materials will be supplied by LCCB. We would be happy to design programs on other topics at your request. Please limit winter programs to two-three per classroom to give each school an opportunity to schedule.

Tails & Furry Animals of Iowa

Students will listen to the story *Tails*, learn about furry Iowa animals, touch animal furs, play a matching body and tails animal game, and receive Iowa animal color sheets.

Skunk

Preschoolers will listen to a skunk story. They will learn why skunks sprays, what they eat, touch a fur, examine a skunk skull, and make a skunk craft.

Beaver

Preschoolers will explore the busy world of the beaver. They will listen to *Busy Beavers*, touch a beaver fur & skull, examine beaver logs, and make a beaver craft.

Fishy Fun

Preschoolers will learn about common Iowa fish thorough a story and puppets. They will have a chance to catch magnetic fish and make fish prints. Participants will receive a Fish IA button and coloring book.

Birds

Preschoolers will listen to the story *Bird Calls*, listen to IA birds, make a stuffed bird craft, and do a bird movement dance.

Spring is here

Preschoolers will listen to a story to learn about plants and animals that become most active during the spring season. They will get a chance to feel furs, listen to birds, and make a craft related to the story.

Insects

Preschoolers will learn the basics about insects. Listen to the story *Big Bugs, A Pop Up Book*. Learn about an insect's life cycle, play an insect color game, and make a craft using insect stamps.

Bear Snores On

Students will listen to the story *Bear Snores On*. They will learn about animals in Iowa that hibernate in the winter time, sing a hibernation song, and receive an activity book.
