## **LEE COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT TESTING INFORMATION**

The Lee County Sheriff's Office has scheduled police officer and/or deputy testing for the following Law Enforcement agencies: Fort Madison Police Department and the Lee County Sheriff's Office. These exams will be held on **Saturday June 8th, 2019 at the Central Lee High School and the Lee County Sheriff's Office.**

This testing Process consists of two parts: an agility test and a written exam. You must be at the Central Lee High School gym at 9am sharp for agility test (see attached). If you pass all parts of the agility test, you then will be eligible to take the written test which will be administered at the Lee County Sheriff's Office. Applicants must pass all agility tests and all sections of the written test to be eligible for further consideration by the law enforcement agencies. Enclosed is the "Application to Test" that must be completed and received at the Lee County Sheriff's Office on or before **May 24th, 2019**. If this "Application to test is not received by May 24th, 2019, you will not be eligible to test on June 8th, 2019.
